





THE RIGHT CONNECTIONS


Melbourne has been named the world's most liveable city for the fourth time. Aurora Melbourne Central provides unrivalled access to all that Melbourne offers. Its cosmopolitan cluster of food and beverage offerings, retail hub, street-level arcade and laneway activation reflect this vibrant city's determination to live well.

Escalators from the ground level of the development will provide direct access to a new, vibrant food and beverage retail precinct connecting directly through to Melbourne Central, the CBD's largest shopping centre, and from there to the new Emporium Shopping Centre, Myer, David Jones and the Bourke Street Mall. Specialty stores, supermarkets and services are on your doorstep.


This is the first and only residential development with direct underground connection to Melbourne's railway loop. The basement link to Melbourne Central Station connects to a network transporting you throughout the metropolitan area and beyond. Aurora Melbourne Central is just two stations away from Southern Cross Station, the transport hub for train and coach travel throughout Victoria and interstate, and the terminal for coaches to and from Melbourne Airport. Just around the corner less than 50m away is Swanston Street, Melbourne's transport spine. Swanston Street trams get you to Melbourne University in seven minutes or the National Gallery of Victoria in eight.


A LUMINOUS PRESENCE

Aurora Melbourne Central will be a self-contained community, catering to your every need. Shops and cafés in the public laneway and internal arcade add to Melbourne's rich street texture, while the basement level provides allweather access to the train station entry. A connection at the lower ground level takes you to Melbourne Central, with its cinemas, fitness centre, shopping, bars and restaurants. From the ground level you can easily access the State Library lawns - a relaxing spot to take in the best of the weather.

Aurora Melbourne Central will have an Australian Green Star rating in excess of 4-star. There's natural ventilation to the podium car park, real-time display of common area energy and water use, and rainwater harvesting for building facilities.
